



RESOLUTION 2012-060

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE WITH THE SHERWOOD SCHOOL DISTRICT TO INSTALL LIGHTS ON FIELDS AT THE RIDGES CAMPUS AND SHERWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOL/HOPKINS SCHOOL CAMPUS

WHEREAS, the 2006 Parks and Recreation Master Plan identifies the need to light sport fields to maximize field space and use; and

WHEREAS, several youth sport leagues have come to the City and the Parks and Recreation Board and expressed a desire to light more fields; and

WHEREAS, each year sports leagues spend funds renting portable temporary lights that are expensive to operate, require a generator and put out inadequate light; and

WHEREAS, at the December 3, 2012 meeting, the Parks & Recreation Board voted to recommend that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate with the School District to install lights on fields at the Ridges Campus and Sherwood Middle School/Hopkins School Campus.

WHEREAS, at the December 3, 2012 meeting, the Parks & Recreation Board voted to recommend that the City Council authorize the City Manager to spend up to \$400,000 in Parks SDC funds for the lighting project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to begin negotiations with the School District to install field lights on the Ridges Campus and Sherwood Middle School.

Section 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to spend up to \$400,000 in Parks SDC funds for the lighting project.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
