



RESOLUTION 2017-052

DECLARING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD'S ELECTION TO RECEIVE STATE REVENUES

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statute 221.770, provides for Oregon municipalities to receive state revenues should they elect to via resolution or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said statute also requires the electing municipality to hold two public hearings on the municipality's use of the funds; and


WHEREAS, on May 11, 2017, a public hearing on the use of state revenues was held by the City of Sherwood Budget Committee and on June 20, 2017, a public hearing on the use of state revenues was held by the Sherwood City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Pursuant to ORS 221.770, the City of Sherwood hereby elects to receive state revenues for the Fiscal Year 2017-18.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
