



**RESOLUTION 2017-039**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKLINE, INC.  
FOR THE 2017 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City has a responsibility to maintain the City's infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the City partnered with the City of Hillsboro to include Sherwood's 2017 Slurry Seal program in their RFP for the same services; and

**WHEREAS**, the RFP process identified Blackline, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder.


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackline, Inc. in the amount not to exceed \$95,059;

**Section 2.** Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract change order(s) for a total amount not to exceed 10% of the original award (\$104,565).

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
