APPOINTING VANCE STIMLER TO THE SHERWOOD POLICE ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, the Police Advisory Board currently has vacancies in position 8 and 9; and

WHEREAS, the term of office for both vacancies expires on June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised the vacant positions and sought interested applicants; and

WHEREAS, City Councilor Kim Young, Board Chair Ralph Lohman and Police Chief Jeff Groth interviewed Vance Stimler and recommend Vance Stimler for appointment to position 9; and

WHEREAS, according to chapter 2.08 of the Sherwood Municipal Code, members of the Police Advisory Board shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of City Council; and


WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes that Vance Stimler would be a valuable member of the Board; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to appoint Vance Stimler to the Sherwood Police Advisory Board, for a three (3) year term that expires on June 30, 2022.
