### APPOINTING STEVEN REMSEN TO THE SHERWOOD LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD

**WHEREAS**, the Library Advisory Board currently has vacancies in position 3 and 6; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of office for both vacancies expires on June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the City advertised the vacant positions and sought interested applicants; and

**WHEREAS**, City Councilor Renee Brouse, Board Chair D'Ann Wells and Library Manager Adrienne Doman Calkins interviewed Steven Remsen and are recommending Steven Remsen for appointment to position 6; and

**WHEREAS**, according to chapter 2.08 of the Sherwood Municipal Code, members of the Library Advisory Board shall be appointed by the Mayor, with the consent of City Council; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes that Steven Remsen would be a valuable member of the Board; and
